**Recalculating: When Plans Change** When My Actions Change My Plans

Matthew 26:31–35 (HCSB)

Then Jesus said to them, "Tonight all of you will run away because of Me, for it is written: I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered. 32 But after I have been resurrected, I will go ahead of you to Galilee." 33 Peter told Him, "Even if everyone runs away because of You, I will never run away!" 34 "I assure you," Jesus said to him, "tonight, before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times!" 35 "Even if I have to die with You," Peter told Him, "I will never deny You!" And all the disciples said the same thing.

Matthew 26:69-75 (HCSB)

Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. A servant approached him and she said, "You were with Jesus the Galilean too." 70 But he denied it in front of everyone: "I don't know what you're talking about!" 71 When he had gone out to the gateway, another woman saw him and told those who were there, "This man was with Jesus the Nazarene!" 72 And again he denied it with an oath, "I don't know the man!" 73 After a little while those standing there approached and said to Peter, "You certainly are one of them, since even your accent gives you away." 74 Then he started to curse and to swear with an oath, "I do not know the man!" Immediately a rooster crowed, 75 and Peter remembered the words Jesus had spoken, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.

	Proverbs 16:18 (HCSB)  Pride comes before destruction, and an arrogant spirit before a fall.
	<ul> <li>Make sure your mouth doesn't write checks your can't cover.</li> <li>Peter boasted:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Freter boasted.</li> <li>From his true love of Jesus.</li> <li>From his reliance on his own strength.</li> <li>From his lack of self-awareness and understanding of what was about to come.</li> </ul>
3.	SIN AND DISOBEDIENCE ARE NEVER FROM EVEN THE MOST FAITHFUL vv 69-74
	<ul> <li>We may think we are above sin, but it's always lurking around the corner.</li> <li>Every one of us has the to disobey God.</li> </ul>
4.	WE CAN BE USED AGAIN BY GOD WHEN WE OVER-CONFIDENCE WITH HUMILITY AND REPENTANCE v 75
	<ul> <li>Genuine brings God's forgiveness.</li> <li>God can use us even if we have messed up.</li> </ul>
