Generosity the Right Way

Luke 14:12–14 (HCSB)

He also said to the one who had invited Him, "When you give a lunch or a dinner, don't invite your friends, your brothers, your relatives, or your rich neighbors, because they might invite you back, and you would be repaid. <sup>13</sup> On the contrary, when you host a banquet, invite those who are poor, maimed, lame, or blind. <sup>14</sup> And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

## Matthew 6:1-4 (HCSB)

"Be careful not to practice your righteousness in front of people, to be seen by them. Otherwise, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven. <sup>2</sup> So whenever you give to the poor, don't sound a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be applauded by people. I assure you: They've got their reward! <sup>3</sup> But when you give to the poor, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, <sup>4</sup> so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.
