A New Day

A New Day for His Disciples

Luke 24:36–49 (HCSB)

And as they were saying these things, He Himself stood among them. He said to them, "Peace to you!"³⁷ But they were startled and terrified and thought they were seeing a ghost.³⁸ "Why are you troubled?" He asked them. "And why do doubts arise in your hearts?"³⁹ Look at My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself! Touch Me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see, I have."⁴⁰ Having said this, He showed them His hands and feet.⁴¹ But while they still were amazed and unbelieving because of their joy, He asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?"⁴² So they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish,⁴³ and He took it and ate in their presence.⁴⁴ Then He told them, "These are My words that I spoke to you while I was still with you - that everything written about Me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms must be fulfilled."⁴⁵ Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.⁴⁶ He also said to them, "This is what is written: The Messiah would suffer and rise from the dead the third day,⁴⁷ and repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning at Jerusalem.⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things.⁴⁹ And look, I am sending you what My Father promised. As for you, stay in the city until you are empowered from on high."
