## **SHIFT: ReThinking Your Parenting**

Rethinking Performance-Based vs. Purpose-Filled

Psalm 78:1-7 (HCSB)

My people, hear my instruction; listen to what I say. <sup>2</sup> I will declare wise sayings; I will speak mysteries from the past – <sup>3</sup> things we have heard and known and that our fathers have passed down to us. <sup>4</sup> We must not hide them from their children, but must tell a future generation the praises of the LORD, His might, and the wonderful works He has performed. <sup>5</sup> He established a testimony in Jacob and set up a law in Israel, which He commanded our fathers to teach to their children <sup>6</sup> so that a future generation - children yet to be born - might know. They were to rise and tell their children <sup>7</sup> so that they might put their confidence in God and not forget God's works, but keep His commands.

2.	PURPOSE-FILLED TRAINING PUTS THE FOCUS ON POWER
