## Stuck: Destructive Lies We Tell Ourselves I'm Not Good Enough

## 1 Corinthians 1:26-31 (HCSB)

US vv 26-28

Brothers, consider your calling: Not many are wise from a human perspective, not many powerful, not many of noble birth. <sup>27</sup> Instead, God has chosen what is foolish in the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen what is weak in the world to shame the strong. <sup>28</sup> God has chosen what is insignificant and despised in the world - what is viewed as nothing—to bring to nothing what is viewed as something, <sup>29</sup> so that no one can boast in His presence. <sup>30</sup> But it is from Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became God-given wisdom for us - our righteousness, sanctification, and redemption, <sup>31</sup> in order that, as it is written: The one who boasts must boast in the Lord.
